## **Submission of Papers**

Only full papers in pdf-format may be submitted. Papers should be submitted to Metin Kaptan, by sending an e-mail to [kaptan@insiwo.de](mailto:kaptan@insiwo.de).

**Deadline for paper submission is May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012.**

Authors are not allowed to submit more than one paper. All submitted papers will be peer reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process overviewed by the Scientific Committee. A selection based on quality will take place to guarantee a small-scaled event.

Paper presenters are expected to discuss one other paper during the workshop. The discussant assignments will be made by the workshop organizers at a later date. As the workshop intends to build a network in this research area, participation is welcome even without paper contributions.

## **Registration Fee**

### **Location**

### **Travel**

Getting to Muenster is well served with a variety of transport routes:

#### *By Air*

Several carriers offer direct flights to Münster/Osnabrück Airport (FMO). However, there is also variety of further airports in the vicinity such as Dortmund (60 km), Bremen (144 km), and Düsseldorf (96 km), which are well connected to Muenster by train. For people arriving at FMO, an express bus - "FMO-Express" - is available to take them to Muenster Main Station (travel time approx. 30 minutes). #### *By Rail*

Muenster is situated at the main rail line from Hamburg to the Ruhr Area. Express trains to the north and south run approximately every hour. For further information please visit [www.db.de](http://www.db.de).

#### *By Car*

Muenster is directly situated on the A1 Motorway. Leave the motorway at any of the two exits and follow the signposts into the city centre.

### *Public transport*

Around 20 city bus routes link the various districts with the inner city, while the city express, taxi bus and night buses supplement these services around the clock. The main bus station is directly in front of the train station. Destinations within the Muensterland region are also accessible by bus.
