# **Workshop Objectives**

This workshop provides an opportunity for all those interested in the **New Economics** to discuss their research and to exchange ideas. The New Economy is commonly believed to have started in the late 1990s, when high tech tools, particularly the Internet and increasingly powerful and fast computers, made their way into the consumer and business marketplace. The New Economy has been seen as a shift from a manufacturing and commodity-based economy to one that uses technology to create new products and services at a rate that the traditional manufacturing economy could not match. It is also linked with the so-called Industrial Revolution 4.0.

Researchers are invited to submit both empirical and theoretical papers that are broadly consistent with the workshop's special topic. However, in particular we welcome papers related to the following topics:

- Economic theory in the face of the fourth industrial revolution
- Technology factors in theoretical economic models
- New challenges for the digital economy
- The impact of a new technology on an economic development, a labor market and inequalities (big data, blockchain and distributed ledger technology (DLT), smart contracts, Artificial Intelligence (AI), machine learning etc.)
- Future of collaborative economy and its components (sharing economy, collaborative finance, collaborative production, gig economy, etc.)
- Financial technology (FinTech) versus traditional banking services
- GovTech governments towards a new technology
- Regulatory Technology (RegTech, SupTech) and its application to governance and supervision
- Cryptocurrencies, tokenization processes and the shape of future financial system
- Digitalization as a driving force for industrial enterprises
- BigTech and its impact on economic and financial stability
- Crowdfunding services and platforms
- Rising role of personalized and dynamic pricing
- The role of cybersecurity in the digital economy
- Ethical and social aspects of new technologies

The workshop is open to both young and experienced researchers, Ph.D. students, post-doctoral researchers, and professionals from business, government and non-governmental institutions.

Please submit your full paper by November 15, 2020.

Authors are allowed to submit more than one paper. We will confirm receipt of your submission.

All submitted papers will be peer reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process.

You will receive an e-mail indicating whether your paper is accepted for presentation during the workshop or not before **December 15, 2020**.

Paper presenters are expected to discuss one other paper during the workshop. The discussant assignments will be made by the workshop committee before January 31, 2021. As the workshop intends to build a network in this research area, participation is welcome even without paper contributions.







#### **Publication of Papers**

A selection of papers presented at the workshop will be published in one or more international publications. **INFER** offers several publication possibilities to workshop participants, including journal publications.

**PUEB** offers to publish good papers as a chapter of the monograph issued by highly reputable publisher (e.g. Springer, Palgrave Macmillan) and in a quarterly journal The Economics and Business Review.

The workshop organizers will contact you about these publication possibilities later.
